

TOWN HOUSE ADVISORY GROUP
MINUTES
April 25, 2019

1. Rocky outlined THAG's activities over the past several years for the benefit of Susan and Tim who may join THAG on a regular basis. There ensued a brief discussion of additional revenue ideas, including possibly a John O'Brien film series.
2. Annual Clean up Day is Sunday April 28, at 11 AM until 2 PM
3. THAG's Annual Fund Raising event is coming up on June 8. Paul reported that Still Hill is all lined up to provide music. Brocklebank Brewery will provide libations. Steve will coordinate hors d'oeuvres with Martha, Shannon Varley, Susanne Lupian, and possibly Donna Hollinger.
4. The backhouse will be activated shortly by Silas.
5. Maintenance: Rocky to coordinate with Eli Mintz regarding the removal of one of the maple trees on the West side of the building. Rocky will also coordinate with Tom Root regarding electrical work to be done this year. The priorities are lighting, additional outlets, and general wiring upgrades.
6. Paul review ether music schedule for the coming season. Emma Beck will perform early in the season. Dixie and the Diamonds will perform June 29. Paul is also moving forward with a Sunday afternoon jazz series, three or four performances in total. To date two concerts are definite. Paul advised that he has received a second spot light from his preferred vendor, Sweetwater.
7. Rocky outlined his discussions with Dave Taplin and Stef and Bob Johnston regarding the removal of the road in front of the Town House. They are supportive of the idea of removal. The removal of the road would serve to connect the Town House to the common. Discussions are at a very preliminary stage. The matter will need to go before the Selectboard and ultimately the town residents.
